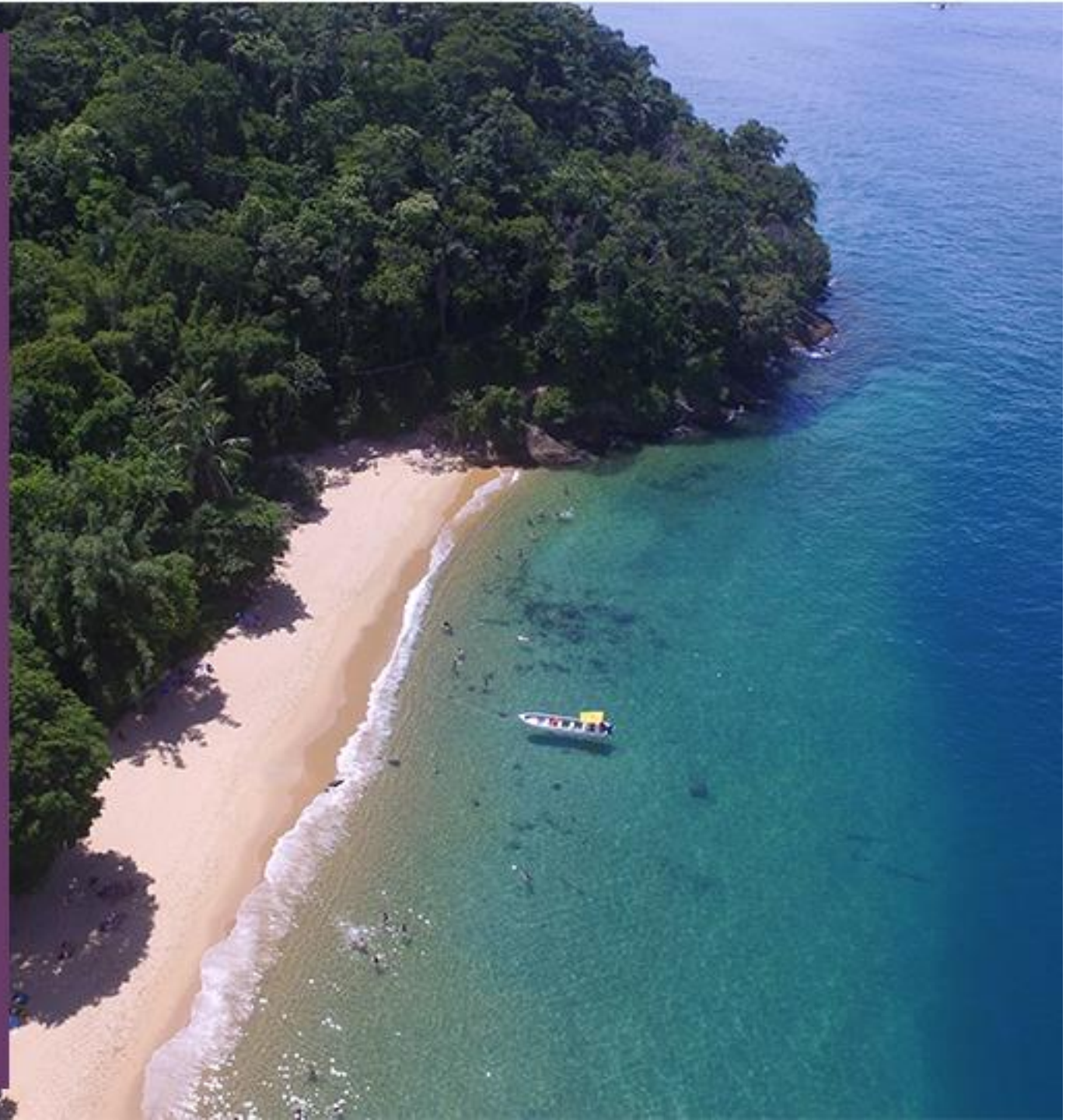


# DAY 4

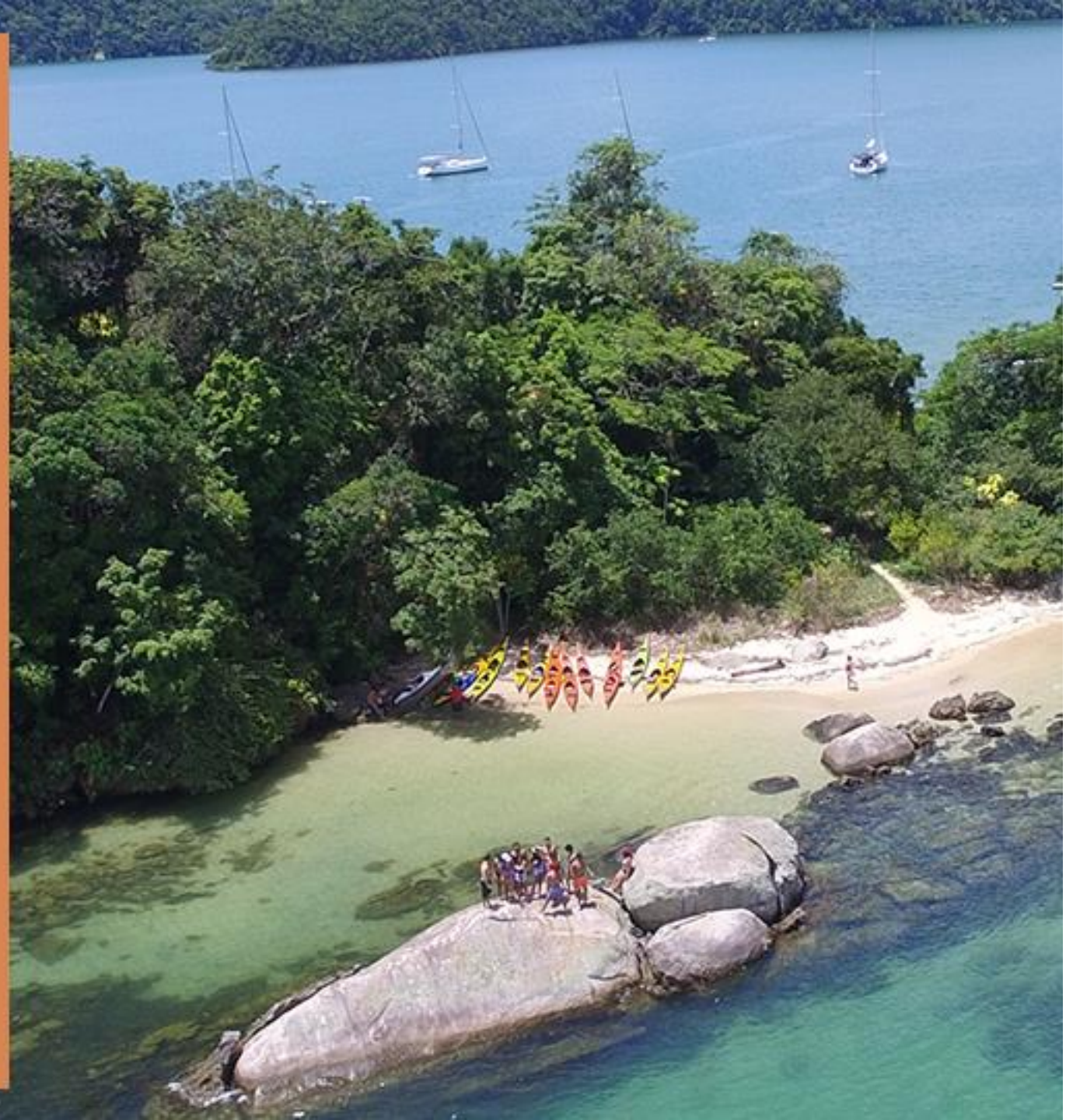


# DAY 5

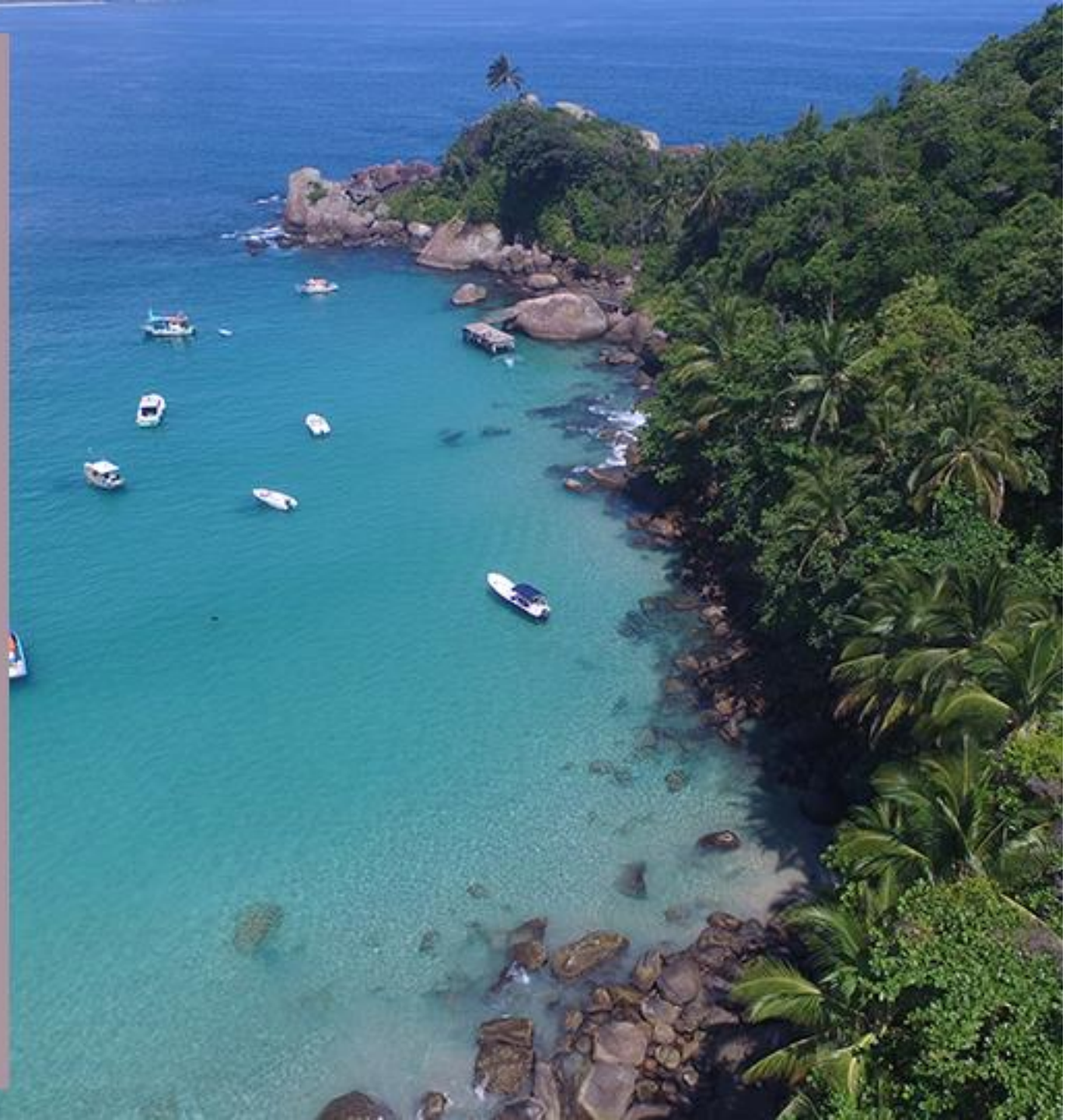


# DAY 8

7. Bank statements containing the account holder's name, current balance and transactions from the last 6 months

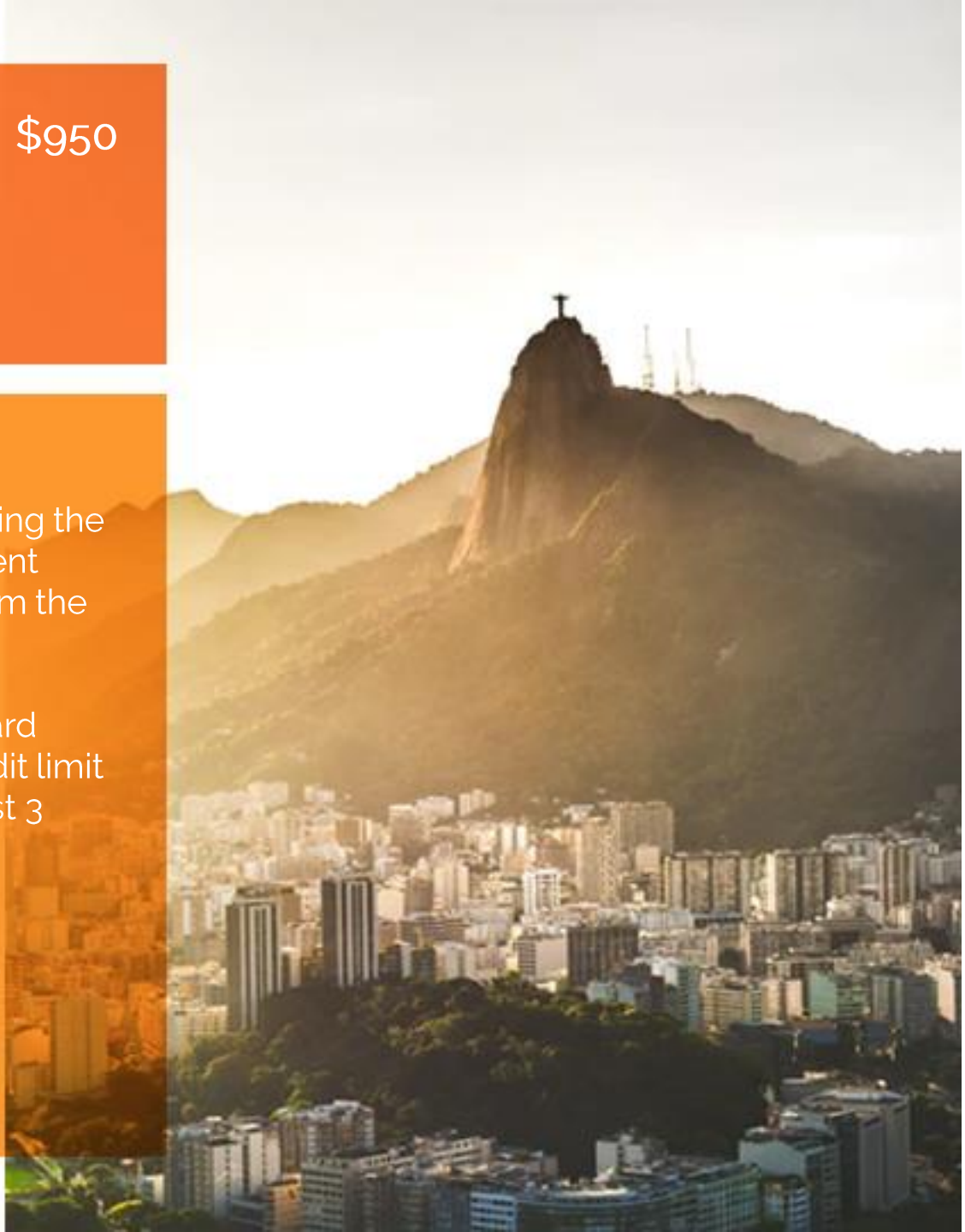
